Rules and Regulations

Presented by the Friends of Canaveral, Inc. (FOC) a 501(c)(3), to benefit
environmental educational activities for children and adults at
Canaveral National Seashore

1. Turtles will be launched into the Indian River Lagoon at Canaveral National Seashore at a time and date selected by FOC Race Committee (Committee). The race course will be established by the Committee taking into consideration weather conditions, tides and winds.
2. Turtles remain the property of FOC.
3. Once turtles are launched, they are subject to the weather and tidal conditions. No attempt to interfere with any turtle is permitted, unless deemed necessary by the Committee. The race course will close after the last turtle crosses the finish line.
4. A number will be attached to each turtle relating to the number on any entry ticket. Multiple turtle entries from one ticket will be assigned turtle numbers for identification. The individual's name that appears on the entry ticket corresponding to the turtles in order of race finish (First, Second, Third and Last) will be awarded prizes. The prizes are determined by the Committee and notice of available prizes will be published on the FOC website and on flyers related to the event.
5. The entry portion of each race ticket must be completely filled out and delivered to FOC, or its representative, and received by the Committee one (1) hour prior to start of the race. Entrants assume the risk of non-delivery of any entries as set forth herein.
6. Winners will be announced immediately following the race at the site of event. Winners need not be present to win. All winners assume the sole responsibility for payment of any taxes on the prizes as required by law.
7. By entering, each entrant releases FOC and Canaveral National Seashore and its members, directors, agents, employees and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to the prizes. Additionally, each entrant, if deemed a winner, consents to promotional use of their names and likeness without additional compensation.
8. All decisions and interpretations of these rules and regulations will be made by the Committee and their decision is final.
9. If the Committee determines, in its sole discretion, that the race cannot occur at the schedule time for any reason, then they can postpone the race to another date and time by public announcement thereof.
